# Supplemental Digest Department of Human Services May 2014

Today I am releasing the report for the Department of Human Services (Department). The Department report contains a financial audit for the year ending June 30, 2013 and a compliance attestation examination for the two years ending June 30, 2013. For the two years ending June 30, 2013 separate engagements were not performed at the Department's individual centers; instead limited testing was performed at the centers and the results of those procedures, as applicable, were incorporated into the Department's report. It should also be noted that the Department closed three facilities during this review period: Tinley Park Mental Health Center, H. Douglas Singer Mental Health and Developmental Center, and Jacksonville Developmental Center.

Summaries of certain operational and statistical data have been included in the attached charts and schedules. For example, one chart provides details on the average number of residents / students by center. This chart also groups the centers by function and provides subtotals by function and for the Department as a whole. According to Department figures, for fiscal year 2013, the Department had an average total population of 3,880 residents / students at centers, compared to 4,065 for fiscal year 2012 and 4,180 for fiscal year 2011.

Another chart provides details on the average cost per year per resident / student by center and also groups the centers by function. This chart notes the average cost for fiscal year 2013, 2012 and 2011 as data was available. According to the Department, for 2013 the average cost per year per resident / student ranged from a high of \$398,273 at Chicago-Read Mental Health Center to a low of \$47,586 at the Treatment and Detention Center.

The final chart provides information regarding the value of paid overtime hours and earned compensatory hours, number of employees per center and the ratio of employees to residents / students at the centers. Using information provided by the Department for fiscal year 2013, the number of employees per resident / student ranged from a high of 2.86 at Chicago-Read Mental Health Center to a low of .40 at the Treatment and Detention Facility.


#### **AVERAGE NUMBER OF RESIDENTS/STUDENTS**



## AVERAGE COST PER YEAR RESIDENT/STUDENT


