
Today, the Office of the Auditor General is releasing the report for the Department of Veterans' Affairs (Department). The Department report contains the results of a compliance attestation examination for the two years ending June 30, 2012. For the two years ending June 30, 2012, separate engagements were not performed at the Department's Veterans' Homes; instead, limited testing was performed at each Home and the result of those procedures, as applicable, were incorporated into the Department's report.

Summaries of certain operational and statistical data provided by the Department have been included in the attached charts and schedules. For example, one chart provides details on the average total resident population and rate resident capacity by Veterans' Home, divided into yearly cost per skilled care resident and domiciliary care resident. For 2012, the average yearly cost per skilled care resident ranged from \$110,569 (Anna) to \$89,027 (LaSalle) and the average cost per domiciliary care resident ranged from \$109,854 (Anna) to \$46,840 (Quincy). For 2011, the average yearly cost per skilled care resident ranged from \$99,459 (Quincy) to \$89,797 (Manteno) and the average cost per domiciliary care resident ranged from \$95,597 (Anna) to \$52,071 (Quincy).

The next two charts provide information regarding the number of employees per Veterans' Home, the ratio of skilled care residents to employees at each home, and the ratio of domiciliary care residents to employees at each home. Another chart provides information regarding the number of resident injuries. The final chart provides the total number of days care was furnished to veterans at each home.






Average Yearly Cost Per Resident




Residents per Employee
