The Legislative Audit Commission was created as a legislative support services agency subject to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 1984 (25 ILCS 150). The Commission is also to determine what remedial measures, if any, are needed and whether special studies and investigations are needed and, if deemed necessary, direct the Auditor General to undertake such studies or investigations.
