INTRODUCTION

The Department of Military Affairs was established by the Military Code of Illinois (20 ILCS 1805/20; formerly, Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 129, par. 220.20). The Department acts as the channel of communication between the federal government and the State of Illinois on all matters pertaining to the State Military. The Adjutant General prepares and executes plans for organizing, supplying, equipping, and mobilizing the Organized Militia for use in national defense, State defense, and emergencies.

FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS

There were three compliance findings reported. These findings are procedural in nature and have been given appropriate attention by the Department. We will review the Department's progress towards the implementation of our recommendations in our next audit.
