INTRODUCTION

The Upper Illinois River Valley Development Authority (Authority) is a general development agency for the counties of Bureau, Grundy, Kane, Kendall, LaSalle, Marshall, McHenry, and Putnam and is one of ten regional development authorities within the State of Illinois. The Authority has the ability to issue up to \$500 million in bonds on behalf of manufacturing firms to encourage the creation of jobs. With the Governor's approval, the Authority could issue Moral Obligation Bonds backed by the State of Illinois until August 11, 2011.

Our special limited scope compliance examination was restricted to appropriations made by the Illinois General Assembly to the Authority from the General Revenue Fund and related expenditures.

We conducted a special limited scope compliance examination of appropriations made by the General Assembly to the Authority and expenditures from State funds as authorized by the Illinois State Auditing Act.
