was provided); access (consumers should be able to view and
contest the accuracy and completeness of data collected about

24 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 25 we direct the Auditor General to conduct an audit of each 26 State officer and agency that maintains a World Wide Web site 27 28 and determine whether the officer or agency uses technology that allows it to track the browsing or buying habits of 29 Internet users who visit the site and, if so, whether the 30 tracking is necessary and whether the officer or agency 31 protects those users through adequate notice, choice, access, 32
