# FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS, AND RECOMMENDATIONS

#### UNIMPLEMENTED LONG-RANGE MASTER PLAN

The Office of the Architect of the Capitol (Office) has not completed or implemented a long-range master plan of development for the State's Capitol Building and legislative complex.

# Long-range master plan not implemented

During testing, we noted the Office has not completed or implemented a long-range master plan of development for the State Capitol Building and the remaining portions of the legislative complex that addresses the improvement, construction, historic preservation, restoration, maintenance, repair, and landscaping needs of the State Capitol Building and the remaining portions of the legislative complex. (Finding 1, pages 9-10) **This finding has been repeated since 2009.** 

We recommended the Office take appropriate action to implement its long-range master plan, or seek a legislative remedy.

### Office accepts recommendation

Office officials accepted our recommendation, noting they will continue to take action to implement a long-range master plan. (For the previous Office response, see Digest Footnote #1)

#### **ACCOUNTANT'S OPINION**

The accountants conducted a compliance examination of the Office for the two years ended June 30, 2017, as required by the Illinois State Auditing Act. The accountants stated the Office complied, in all material respects, with the requirements described in the report.
